COP CREATIVITY TECHNIQUES STIMULUS IMAGE METHOD

SOME ADDITIONAL NOTES

This creativity technique can be done with any number of participants. The time approach depends on this number; in average you could plan with app. 90min.

When facilitating the stimulus image method, make use of appreciative questions. Allow yourselves to explore the power of silence and do not force creativity.

Notably, there are no wrong associations or ideas. It must be clear that a transfer does not always work. It is not imperative for the ultimate impact of the practice. The most important is to allow surprising and inspiring your group.

EXAMPLES

An example for a formulated challenge is: *How could we make our local healthy lifestyle initiatives more attractive? Stimulus image analysis records may include descriptions like a baby lying on a colorful dotted carpet or associations of a spirit of departure.*

An example sentence combining the challenge with the components from the stimulus image analysis could be: *If you join our health initiatives, then you feel like a new-born. On if we want to get people better involved, then we need to communicate purposefully.*
